The Dahl Wall Lamp Returns – An Original Design from Norway's Parliament

In 1956, Birger Dahl designed a series of lamps for the renovation of Norway's Parliament building in Oslo. When the building reopened in 1958, the interiors were illuminated by pendants, wall lamps and chandeliers, all carrying Dahl's distinctive modernist signature.

In 2016, Northern reintroduced the Dahl pendant to mark the centenary of Birger Dahl's birth. Now, the series is completed with the chandelier and wall lamp – both part of the original commission, rediscovered in the Parliament building's archives and faithfully brought back into production.

The Dahl Wall Lamp preserves the timeless mid-century geometry that Dahl became known for. A mouth-blown opal glass shade diffuses light evenly, while the subtle brass detailing adds elegance and depth. Designed to spread warmth without glare, it enhances both intimate and social settings.

Available in black with brass details, the Dahl Wall Lamp brings Norwegian design heritage into contemporary interiors, blending function and decoration with effortless grace.






Award-winning designer Birger Dahl (1916–1998) was a pioneer of modern Scandinavian lighting. As head of design at Norwegian electronics firm Sønnico in the mid-20th century, he created a series of works that would define the era, including the Dokka pendant – the first Norwegian lamp to receive a Gold Medal at the Triennale di Milano.

In 1956, Dahl designed a complete lighting scheme for the renovation of Norway's Parliament building. The Dahl series of pendants, chandeliers, and wall lamps was part of this commission, exemplifying his geometric clarity and refined minimalism. Characterised by strict forms softened with gentle contours, his designs continue to feel remarkably contemporary.

Today, Northern's reintroductions of Dahl's classics – including the pendant, wall lamp, and chandelier – ensure that his legacy endures in homes and public spaces worldwide.


